

## 2010 CBC RULE CHANGES

### CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

#### Article VI

##### Currently

Section VI. The Second Vice-President shall be responsible for **all-star selections** and serve as coordinator of any committee so designated by the Executive Board.

##### Change

Section VI. The Second Vice-President shall serve as coordinator of any committee so designated by the Executive Board **and be responsible for the rules and scheduling of the Senior Colt league.**

##### Currently

Section XI. The Executive Board by majority rule will be responsible for all leagues playing schedules and post-season play.

##### Change

Section XI. The Executive Board by majority rule will be responsible for all leagues playing schedules, post-season play, **and all-star team selections.**

### GENERAL RULES

##### Currently

37. To eliminate forfeits during regular season and play offs, players may be called up as needed from:

- Shetland to Pinto
- Yearling to Mustang
- Palomino to Bronco
- Stallion to Pony
- Pony to Colt
- Colt to Senior Colt

With the approval of the two league commissioners. A team may not call up more than three (3) players for a game. The Player(s) will go back to his/her original team after the game. The same three (3) players shall not be called up more than three (3) times during the regular season (colt teams may pull players up not more than 3 times during the regular season) and three (3) times during the playoffs. Players may not move down. Any players that are called up must play in accordance to the rules of that league. All players being called up must be from the same association they are being called up to play for. If an association does not have a team to call up from, they must designate a team to call up players from at the beginning of the season with both league commissioners. This must be approved by both voting reps and both coaches. Two teams may not use the same team for call up players.

### Playing Rules Pee Wee League

##### Add

28. The defensive team will consist of 10 players, with a normal infield and four (4) outfielders. The outfield cannot play closer than five (5) feet behind the imaginary baseline until the ball is hit. All players must participate at a minimum of alternate defensive innings.
