*No pitcher shall appear in a game as a pitcher for three consecutive days, regardless of pitch count. Pitchers reaching their maximum number of pitches in a day while pitching to a batter, may finish pitching to that batter before being removed. Once the umpire-in-chief signals "play" to the pitcher, that pitcher shall become the pitcher of record and their pitch count begin at that point. A pitcher is charged with the number of pitches in the specific calendar day and week in which they are pitched, regardless of whether they are local organization league games, the playoff of postponed games or suspended games, tie games, or exhibition games. Rest is calculated as per calendar day. Any pitcher withdrawn from the mound and/or lineup, or a pitcher who is withdrawn from the mound and stays in the game at another position, shall not be permitted to pitch again in the same game.

Days rest is calendar days. Example if a pitcher pitches 37 pitches on a Monday they are ineligible to pitch on Tuesday and Wednesday. They can pitch again on Thursday.

Additional inning limits per league

No Player in Pinto, Yearling, or Mustang may pitch in more than 9 innings per week, regardless of pitch count.

Pinto 7. Pitcher can only pitch two (2) innings per calendar day.

Yearling 7. Only three (3) innings per game may be pitched by a combination of 10 year olds. Any inning where a 10 year old or combination of 10 year olds pitch is considered one (1) inning

Example #1 10 year old starts inning #3, is relieved by 9 year old who completes the inning. Inning counted as one (1) inning pitched by 10 year old.

Example #2 10 year old starts inning #3, is relieved by another 10 year old who completes the inning. Inning counted as one (1) inning pitched by 10 year old.

Palomino 9. Only three (3) innings per game may be pitched by a combination of 12 year olds. Any inning where a 12 year old or combination of 12 year olds pitch is considered one (1) inning

Example #1 12 year old starts inning #3, is relieved by 11 year old who completes the inning. Inning counted as one (1) inning pitched by 12 year old.

Example #2 12 year old starts inning #3, is relieved by another 12 year old who completes the inning. Inning counted as one (1) inning pitched by 12 year old.

Stallion 9.If an exception is granted for a travel player or High School JV player to play in the Stallion league, under no circumstance are they allowed to pitch in more than 2 combined innings per day
